A message for parents with toddlers

New government regulations about treating 'accidents' in the pool means there is a requirement to close the pool for a longer period of time than previously before. What this means for you is that your lesson may be cut short or you may miss your lesson altogether. To avoid this we ask all parents of toddlers to please follow the below suggestions:

- Non-toilet trained children are required to wear tight-fitting waterproof nappies.
- Take children on toilet breaks every half an hour.
- Check swim nappies every 30-60 minutes.
- Change nappies in nappy change areas only.
- Report any faecal accidents to swimming pool staff.



Lost Property

If you have left something after your swimming lesson please enquire as soon as possible. This ensures the best chance of getting your property back.
