

FEES & CHARGES

An account is maintained for each swimmer in Team Unify and includes the following items:

- Squad Coaching Fees
- Meet Entry Charges
- Equipment and Uniform Charges when incurred
- Miscellaneous Items e.g. Team Travel, Social Functions

To view the details on your family account: log on to the Surrey Park website www.surreyparkswimclub.com.au then click on the My Account tab on the left. It is recommended you regularly sign in and view your account.

SQUAD COACHING FEES

Squad coaching fees are set for each level within the club program taking into consideration the training expectations for each squad and associated costs (e.g. pool hire and coaching salaries). While the Club endeavours to maintain its fees at an affordable level, regular review will be undertaken to take into consideration the costs of delivering the squad program as well as other market factors. **Please refer to the Club's Squad Coaching Fees Policy for further details.**

MEET ENTRY CHARGES

If entries for a particular meet are lodged by Surrey Park, the Club is required to pay for all these. Hence you will be billed for all events entered, regardless of whether or not your child competes.

Note: a small surcharge will be applied by the Club, on a per event basis (currently .50c per event), to offset the costs of administering and processing meet entries for Club swimmers.

EQUIPMENT AND UNIFORM CHARGES

On occasions swimmers may be issued with training equipment specific to their squad needs (e.g. paddles, fins, etc). Charges for these items will be added to swimmers' accounts.

It is preferred that payment for uniform items is made at the time of purchase from the Surrey Park Reception, there may be occasions where swimmers are issued with specific uniform items (e.g. team t-shirts etc). Charges for these items will be added to swimmers' accounts.

MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

Other items may also be charged to accounts. Examples include costs for team travel and social functions.

POOL ENTRY FEES AT AQUALINK BOX HILL

As part of the agreement Surrey Park has with Council to use lane space at Aqualink Box Hill, all competitive squad members are required to pay a pool entry fee for sessions held at this Centre. This entry fee is in addition to the Club's coaching fees.

All Club squad swimmers are encouraged to take out a Swim Membership with Aqualink. There is a concession corporate rate for Club members. If the swimmer accesses the Centre two or more times a week, this works out cheaper than paying each time. It also facilitates entry to the Centre for training.

Note: it is necessary to make an appointment with a consultant to take out an Aqualink membership; phone 9898 2099 or email aqbh.memberships@whitehorse.vic.gov.au to organise this.

Alternatively, swimmers can purchase a 10 swim multi-visit card through Aqualink reception.

Aqualink membership is required to access the Centre for training sessions which start before the Centre opens to the public
