ENTRY INTO LESSONS

Aqualink Swimmers

All swimmers must use the Surrey Park turnstile to enter the aquatic space as all attendance is now being marked via this entry.

How to enter via the turnstiles

We recommend downloading the customer portal APP on your phone. The QR code for the lesson can be found in the swimmer account under the QR code tab. Here you will find the unique code for the swimmer and also the code for the family member to enter. If you do not want to download the APP please let us know and we can email you a copy of the QR codes.

You can also take a screenshot of the QR code and scan this photo when coming in for a lesson or send it to someone if they are bringing your child. Just ensure you have your brightness turned up on your phone. If you are a member of Aqualink we please ask you to not use this to enter for lessons as while you can gain access to the lesson, it will not mark attendance.

For all those that have experienced some difficulties with the turnstiles, while you have been away, we have made some adjustments and our testing so far has shown entry to not be problematic.

If you are coming to lessons with a pram, please see us at reception and we will check you in and issue you with a check in card.


Blackburn Swimmers

We will be trialling check in kiosks towards the middle of term. These kiosks enable you to mark your attendance and see the lane location of your term or make up class. To check in you will do this via the QR code on the customer portal APP or via the mobile phone number of the primary account holder. We will send out further details via email once we get closer to its introduction.

REPORTING OF ABSENCES

Please remember if you are not coming to your lesson for whatever reason to please report this absence via the customer portal. If you are wanting a make-up token then you will only be eligible if you give us at least one

hours' notice and you have not already received one in that month. Swimmers throughout the term will be looking to find a lesson to make up for the one they missed, so in reporting your absence it will free up others to utilise their tokens.



SWIMMING

POLICIES

If you are new to swimming with us, please ensure you have logged into the customer portal to accept our policies. This is a condition of swimming with us and must be done prior to your next lesson.

DIVING

Is your child over the age of 6? Are they level 3 and above? Do they love spinning, jumping and twisting?

If so then dive into our beginner dive lessons. We have some limited spots in our learn to dive programs, with a 15% discount offered if you are also enrolled in our learn to swim program Bookings can be made on the customer portal or speak to a member of our customer service team



HOLIDAY PROGRAMS

All bookings will be open from the Monday the 20th of November. Lessons will be running from both centres over the January School Holidays. Week 1: 2nd to 5th January Week 2: 8th to 12th January

Week 3: 15th to 19th January

Cost: \$25 per lesson for learn to swim, \$27 per lesson for diving and \$60 per lesson for private lessons

NOTE

We do not run diving on a Wednesday due to pool space availability.

All bookings are on a first come basis. Learn to swim is a 30 minute lesson and Learn to dive is a 45 minute lesson. A discount of 15% applies to a swimmer enrolling into a second group lesson whether that be in the same week or across multiple. A discount of 15% applies to the third swimmer group enrolment if from the same family.

No discounts apply to private lessons

OPENING HOURS OVER HOLIDAY PERIOD

Over the holiday period we will be closed on the 21st of December and all public holidays. We will revert to holiday operating hours of Aqualink: Monday to Friday 9.00 am to 5.00 pm and weekends 9.00 am to 1.00 pm Blackburn: Monday to Friday 9.00 am to 2.00 pm and Weekends we will be closed You can find our opening hours on our website.
